### UPDATE !! UPDATE !!

WELL, what is happening at the Exhibit?? HAVE I GOT NEWS FOR YOU—The pond is happening !! As we are celebrating the time of THANKSGIVING this month—the pond has found a sponsor (s) and TTSBE is certainly giving our thanks to — *HOLT/CAT* (of San Antonio) and *ECAT, Earth-mover Contractors Association of Texas*. They have agreed to finish the construction of the 1.5 acre pond. The plans are in the works to include other equipment companies, contractors and other interested parties to come together and feature a public venue a “Field Day”. The completion will probably take about 10 days. The public will be invited to watch the demonstrations, observe the equipment in action and just learn about the methods of earthmoving, brush clearing, etc.

We have been working behind the scenes for sometime now pushing towards this great outcome. WHAT is still to come is the sponsorship (s) for the fuel that will be needed for all of the equipment. That task is now at hand and the ask is going out through every available channel. The amount of about \$15,000 should supply enough fuel that will be used over the ten day period. Seven different pieces of large equipment will be employed and ECAT will supply the operators.

From the time we first announced the pond project (Ft. Worth convention) to now hasn't been too long but it certainly seemed that way for the fund raising effort.

Howard Hicks (VP Marketing) of Holt/Cat put us in touch with ECAT, Carl Englerth (CEO). On November 2nd Bill Boytim, project manager and board member along with Donna Dobberfuhl, board member met ECAT members Carl Englerth, Clint Krause of *L.D. Construction* of New Braunfels and Mr. Dennis Foerster of *Custom Services* (dozer work) of Giddings. Mr. Englerth has extensive experience with Dam construction and all three have many years of earthmoving construction. We are in good hands and as more information becomes available it will be made public.

Hopefully the co-ordination will not take too long and all the details will be worked out before the next quarterly meeting of the ECAT board in January.


TTSBE Board members and club representatives of each bonsai society in the state can make these forms available upon request.
